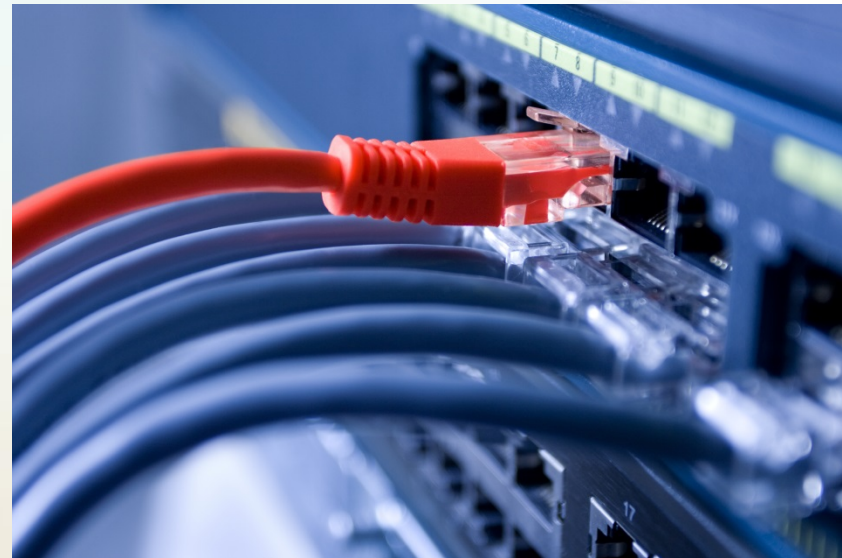


# Recommendations

- **Establish an Innovation Taskforce to explore smart community applications, related applications in business and industry, and workforce requirements**
  - Focus on goals and benefits, define objectives, deployment strategies, identify partners.
- **Develop local broadband infrastructure improvement programs.**
  - Coordinate the programs to ensure consistency across the South Bay area
  - Adopt broadband friendly policies across the South Bay
- **Build a South-Bay Middle-mile Advanced Regional Technology Network (SMART-Net)**
  - Interconnect the South Bay cities, support smart city applications, local control, public safety, fiscal advantages

- 2. Meet with City Staff, Elected Officials, other stakeholders and interested parties**
- 3. Explore the benefits and options with each city**
- 4. Collect letters of interest from cities**
